Overview and Methods

- The youth exchange will be implemented with the attendance of 42 participants from Italy, Turkey, Romania, Spain, Germany and Sweden.
- During the exchange of young people, emphasis will be placed on the use of nonformal education methods.
- The participants will have brainstormings, researches, roleplays, debates and discussions, online interactive games, group and pair works, presentations, problem-solving activities, gathering and telling stories, visits to two different places, daily assessments and an online journal will be completed.

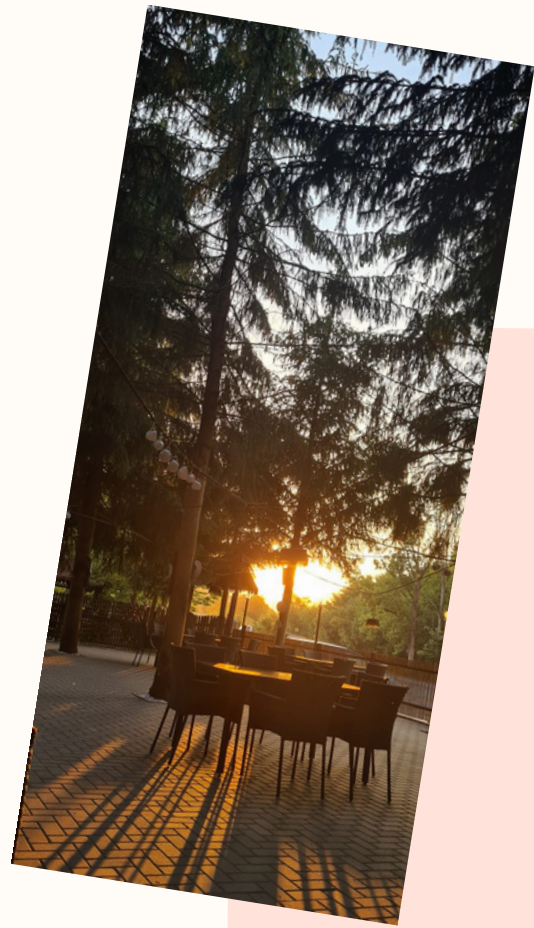

The Venue

THE VENUE OF THE PROJECT IS MILCOVENI VILLAGE. PARTICIPANTS WILL BE ACCOMMODATED INTERNATIONALLY MIXED IN ROOMS OF 3 - 4 BEDS WITH OWN BATHROOM. THERE IS AN EQUIPPED TRAINING ROOM, AN EVENT TENT FOR ACTIVITIES, LEISURE SPACE, A RESTAURANT, WHERE 3 MEALS AND 2 COFFEE BREAKS WILL BE SERVED A DAY.

THE CAMP WILL BE EQUIPPED WITH DISINFECTANT AND MASKS. THE COMMON SPACES WILL BE DISINFECTED ON EACH BREAK (2 COFFEE BREAKS AND LUNCH BREAK).

Travel



- The nearest airport is Timisoara, from where we will pick you up and bring you to the venue (around 150 Km).
- Another option is Belgrade – we can also arrange pick-up but it will be a specific hour for picking up all groups, depending on the arrival of last group

CURRENCY

In Romania the currency is RON, we do not use Euro.
The exchange rate is around 1 EUR= 4.90 RON.



HEALTH INSURANCE

To have EHIC (European Health Insurance Card) or other type of health insurance is mandatory for all participants.

Also, participants will be informed about private companies that can provide insurance.



WEATHER & CLOTHING

In the end of September, the weather starts being cold in Romania, it doesn't snow but they will be rainy days very likely. But sometimes you can even see the sun ☺
We expect 10-20 degrees during the days and 0-10 degrees during the night.

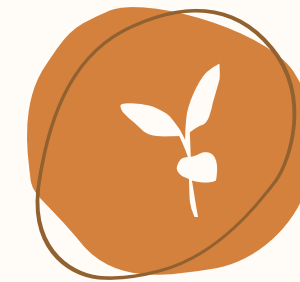
